EASTER PRAYER GUIDE

We're asking God to prepare the hearts of those He has placed in our lives to receive the greatest source of hope: that Jesus is alive!

Over the next four weeks, use the prompts below to guide your daily prayers as you seek God's presence and power to draw others to Him.

DAILY PRAYER PROMPTS

1. Pray for God to move powerfully during *Easter at Woodstock*.
2. Pray for gospel conversations with your friends, neighbors, and coworkers.
3. Pray that our community will find true hope in Jesus.
4. Pray for distractions, doubts, and spiritual barriers to be removed.
5. Pray that the seeds planted during Easter will yield lasting fruit.
6. Pray that our first-time guests feel welcome, seen, and loved.
7. Pray that many who are far from God come to know Him.

WEEKLY PRAYER WALK

If you are physically able, choose one day each week from now until Easter Sunday to pray as you walk through your neighborhood, using the Scriptures and prompts below.

OPEN THE HEAVENS

Pray for God's presence in your neighborhood. That God would press upon the hearts of those in your community their need for Him.

Isaiah 64:1 "Oh, that You would tear open the heavens and come down, that the mountains would quake at Your presence."

OPEN HEARTS

Pray for God to awaken your heart to where He is at work in your neighborhood and to prepare the hearts of your neighbors to receive the Lord.

Acts 2:21 "And it shall be that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

OPEN HANDS

Pray for opportunities to show the love of Christ to those in your neighborhood.

Matthew 25:40 "Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it for one of the least of these brothers or sisters of Mine, you did it for Me."

OPEN HOMES

Pray for open doors to spend time with your neighbors and for boldness to invite them to an Easter service and to share the hope of Jesus.

Acts 2:46-47a "Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people."
